
To The Board of Pardons of the State of Minnesota,
Gentlemen:

Believeing that an unjust verdict was arrived at , and that he is being unjustly imprisoned, I wish to call your attention to the case of Gilbert H. Stephenson, lately sentenced to Stillwater for a term of not more than five years, for an alleged participation in a riot in this city the fifteenth of last June.

That he did not commit, or intend to committ any offense but was only a bystander, is the opinion of ninety per cent of the people of St. Louis County.

I therefor ask that your honorable body grant him an unconditional pardon.
